


VIEWING YOUR PERSONALISED TIMETABLE (STUDENT)

All taught students can view their personalised timetable which, as a minimum, will display activities attended by all students on the course (whole-class; e.g. lectures). A number of Schools also provide group information on the timetable (e.g. tutorials). If you cannot see your group allocation on the timetable, please contact your School in the first instance to check whether they offer this option on the timetable.



Personalised Student Timetables can be accessed via **Studies menu on MyEd**. Then select **Timetables** to access a range of Web Timetables services.

Next, choose **'My Timetable – Student'** from the left side menu. After that, please specify details of the timetable you want to view, such as semester, days and time range.
